E-Safety Parent Workshop



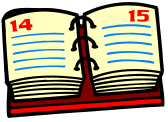
Parents were invited to an E-Safety workshop this week. The importance of checking computer settings, knowing the games children are playing and talking to the children are key to keeping children safe online.

Safeguarding Policy

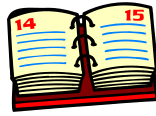
