Governor Update

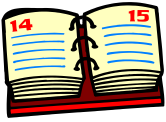
Congratulations to Dayon Haynes who will continue his role as parent Governor and Claire Cameron-Lewis who continues as an Associate Governor.

Safeguarding Policy

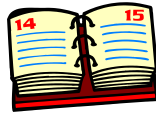
