Year 6 enjoyed the theatre performance as part of their transition work for secondary school. They covered topics such as anti-bullying and making good choices.

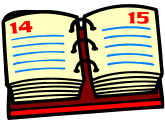

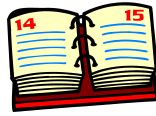
Vision Statement
