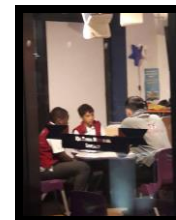
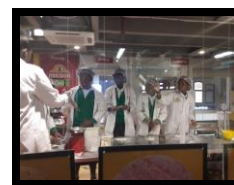


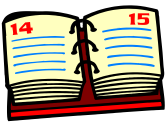
The sun was shining for our Sports Days this week and the children had great fun joining in the different activities. Thank you to parents and carers who joined us.

"I enjoyed the football the most but also enjoyed the running races too," said Jonathan from Year 5.

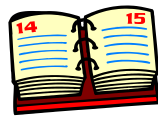
## Kidzania - Pink Class
