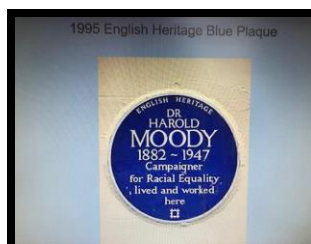
Year 5 and 6 children had a fantastic week on the farm in Gloucestershire being farmers.

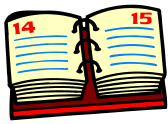

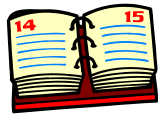


Ms Evans will be leaving us next week after over 4 years at SMMS. She is having a career change and will be greatly missed.
