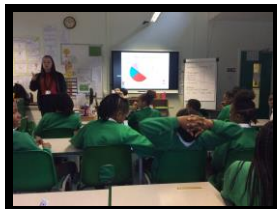

Peckham Walk - Violet Class

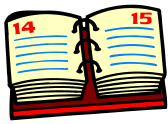
Violet class are learning about the history of our local area with a particular focus on architecture. They walked the length of Rye Lane looking at fine examples - spotting details which they have never noticed before.



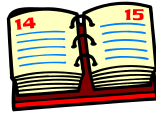
Money Skills Course - Purple Class
